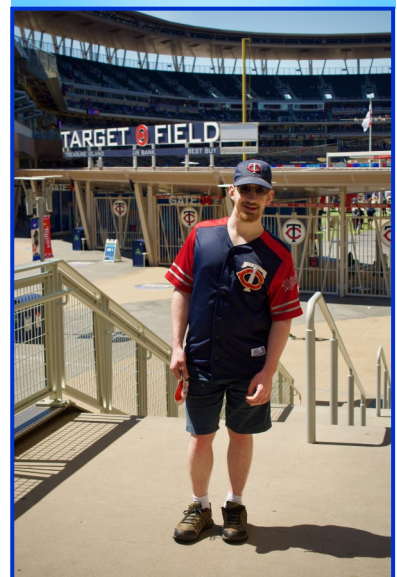
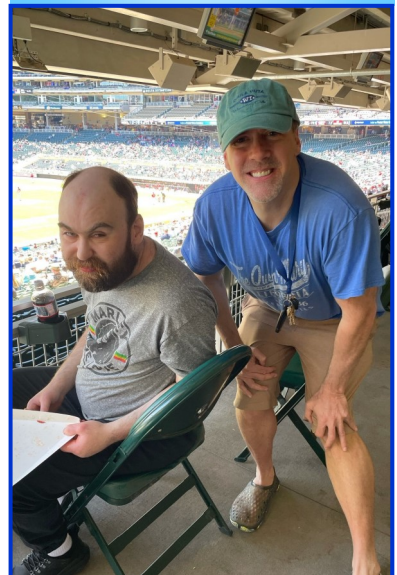

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CARF International Survey Scheduled for August!

We are pleased to announce that CARF International conduct its survey of our organization from Monday, August 23, 2021 through Wednesday, August 25, 2021. Unlike previous surveys that were conducted in person, this survey will be conducted virtually.

This will be our seventh CARF International accreditation survey. Our organization was first accredited in 2003, for three years, and has been reaccredited for every three years since then, including in 2006, 2009, 2012, 2015 and 2018.

The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) is a international, non-profit organization founded in 1966. CARF provides a framework, then consults and advises health and human service organizations to help improve their service quality. CARF accreditation is evidence that an organization strives to improve efficiency, fiscal health, and service delivery, with the goal of helping an organization to create the foundation for stakeholder satisfaction.
